

GPs Fees Guide from 1st June 2024

Your appointment fee will depend on the type of appointment and the duration. If you have a Medicare Card, Medicare will refund to you an amount for this service (Medicare Rebate). You will only be out of pocket the remaining amount.

Below is a list of the most common GPs **Standard Consult** fees. **Please note: Fees are at the discretion of the GP and may vary.** There are other categories of Consults that can be requested from Reception.
